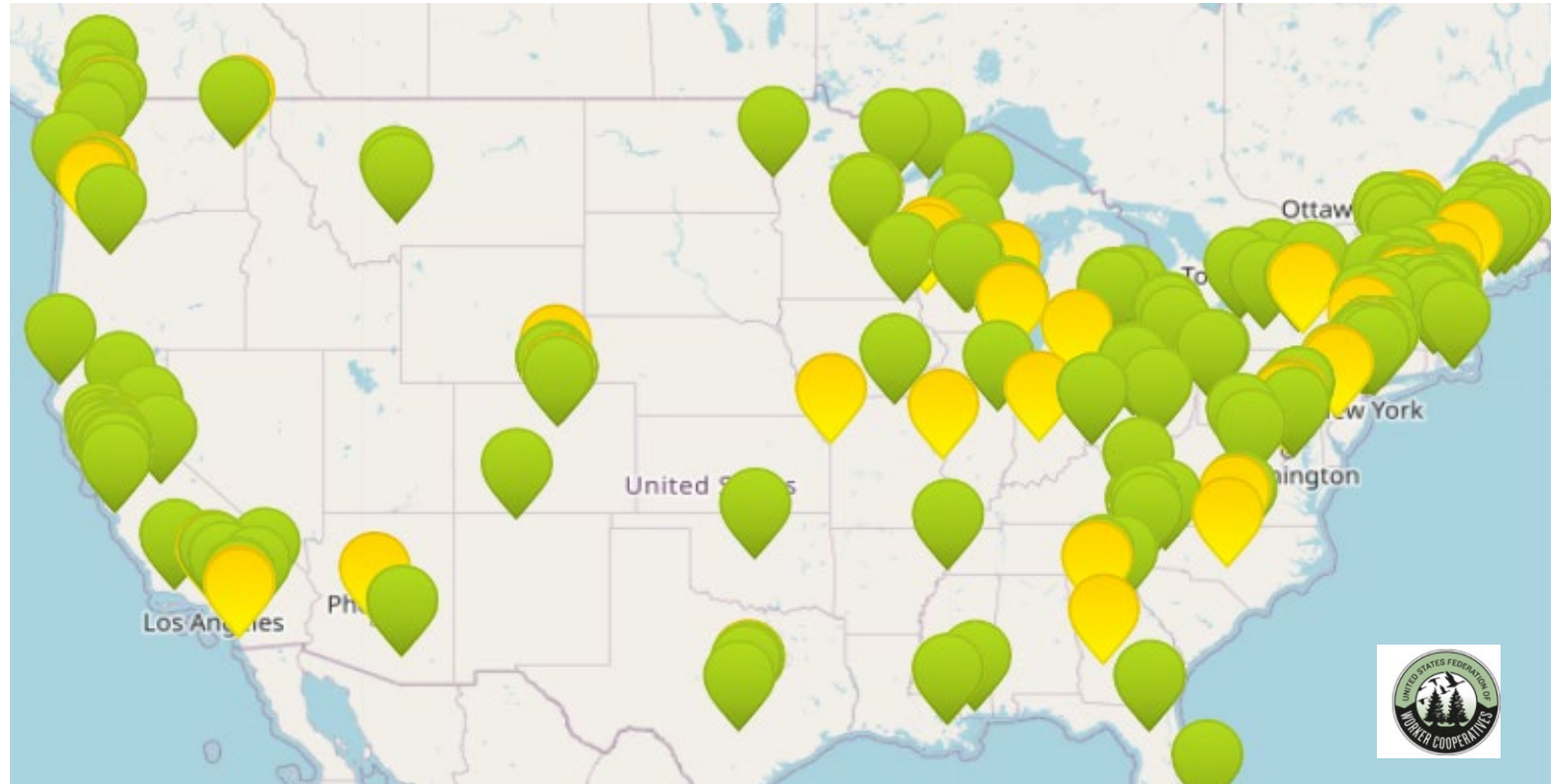
Three strategic approaches

- Endorser Cities: Austin, Berkeley, Boston, Oakland, Philadelphia
- Cultivator Cities: New York City, Madison, Minneapolis
